

Requirements for Technology and Internet Access Policy

To ensure an optimal and effective educational experience for all our students, it is necessary to establish certain minimum requirements regarding the technology needed to participate in our activities and academic programs.

Primary Learning Devices:

Students must have a desktop computer or laptop as the **main tool** for tutoring, access to materials, and learning platforms offered by our school. This requirement is set to ensure that students have the ability to effectively interact with educational resources, complete assigned tasks, and participate in online learning activities without technical limitations.

Use of Mobile Devices:

We recognize the importance and convenience of mobile devices such as cell phones and tablets in today's educational environment. These devices can be used as complementary support tools for learning, allowing access to readings, supplementary material, and educational applications. However, it is important to emphasize that these devices should not be considered substitutes for the required computer or laptop, due to possible limitations in their functionality and capacity for certain academic and technical tasks.

Minimum Requirements for the Computer or Laptop:

To ensure good performance in online educational activities, the student's computer or laptop must meet the following minimum requirements:

- **Operating System:** Windows 10 or higher, macOS 10.13 or higher.
- **Processor:** Intel Core i3 or higher, AMD Ryzen 3 or higher.
- **RAM:** Minimum of 4GB, 8GB recommended.
- **Hard Drive Space:** Minimum of 128GB of available storage.
- **Graphics Card:** Integrated with HD video support.
- **Internet Connection:** The internet connection must be good and stable, allowing the student to connect without problems to all the online learning platforms used by our school. It is essential that the connection efficiently supports the downloading and uploading of files, as well as the smooth conduct of video calls. The quality of the connection should be such that it does not present obstacles to surfing the internet, accessing educational content, submitting assignments, and performing online evaluations.
- **Webcam, Microphone, and Speakers:** For participation in virtual sessions and conducting exams or presentations.
- **Web Browser:** Updated version of Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Safari, or Microsoft Edge.
